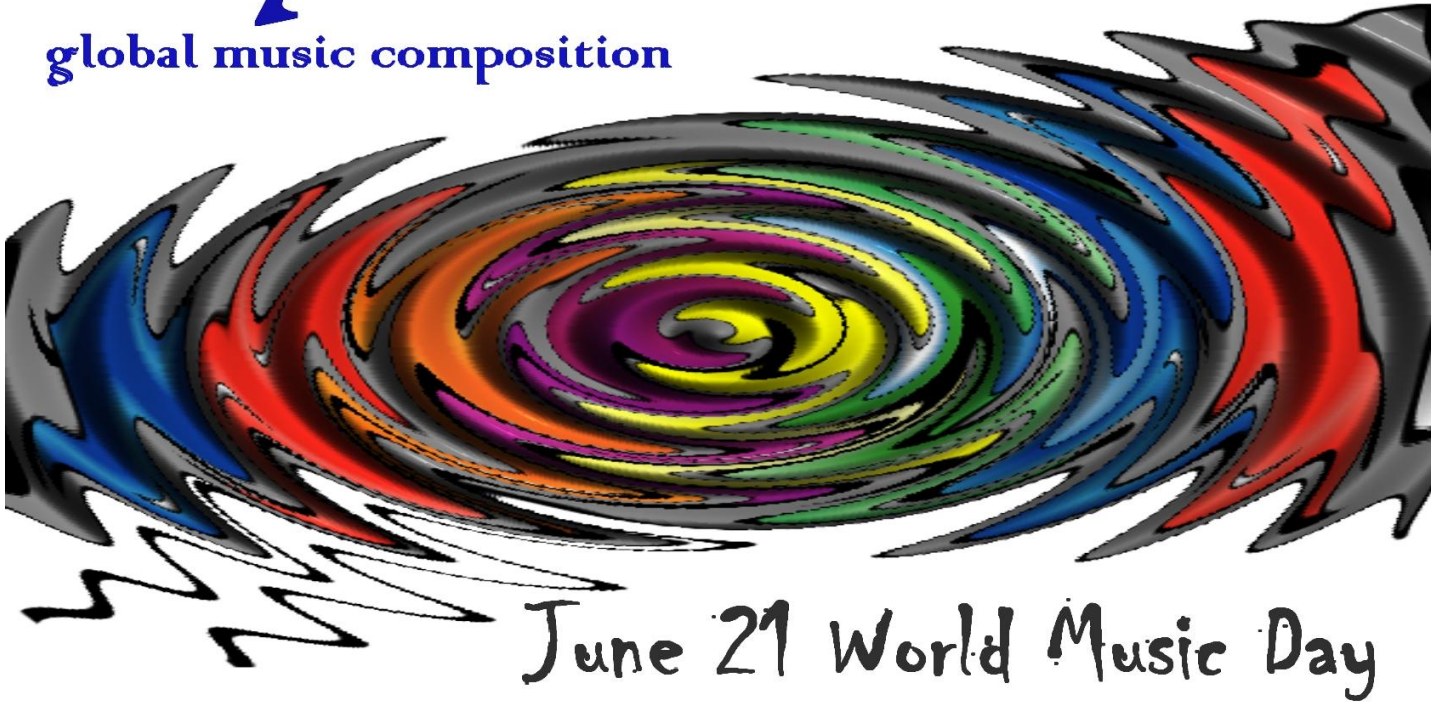

Musicians, Ganesh Kumbla (India), Wilson Magwere (Zimbabwe) & Paul Mcilwaine (Northern Ireland) have recorded basic rhythm tracks that will be emailed across the world and available to download from www.wheelworks.org.uk and caribeworld.org

As the music is passed around the songs will evolve and on June 21st mixed versions will available as a free download. A special program will be broadcasted on Homely Planet.
